# Changes to help you stay healthy AND protect your benefits



## PCP visits cost less: \$10

- Make sure you have a Primary Care Physician (PCP) and see them regularly.
- Your PCP knows your health history and can coordinate your care. They also make sure you get preventive screenings.

## Mental health/substance abuse visits cost less: \$10

## Urgent care visits: \$35

- Use Urgent Care Centers like *Doctors on Duty* and *MoGo* when you have an urgent health issue but can't get an appointment with your PCP.

## Specialist visits: \$40

- Your PCP can help you decide when it's time to see a specialist.

## Save money on prescriptions:

- Medications for diabetes, high blood pressure, and high cholesterol **will cost you less than other drugs** (see ChroniCare copays below). To learn more, call (844) 813-3860 or visit [hospitalityrx.org](http://hospitalityrx.org)
- Other ways to save:
  - Use generic drugs (see copays below)

## Changes to eligibility and enrollment

### Low on hours?

#### Self-payments help you stay covered!

- Self-payments help you continue your eligibility (not establish it for the first time).
- You can self-pay for up to 3 work months each calendar year.
- You can only make a self-payment after a work month in which you were eligible (not after a break in coverage)
- **Track your eligibility online:** log into our member portal at [uhh.org/member](http://uhh.org/member); then click on “member.” (Monthly notices will no longer be mailed.)

How to calculate your self-payment	
Current rate	\$9.73 per hour
Hours	<i>For May - October work months</i>
	130 hours minus the hours your employer credited you with
	<i>For November - April work months</i>
	100 hours minus the hours your employer credited you with
Current rate x hours = self-payment amount	

### Need to add dependents?

#### Open enrollment is once a year in May.

- Unless you have a special event like getting married or the birth or adoption of a child, you can only add dependents during open enrollment.
