

Super Saver option terminated

Super Saver was an optional, temporary, health insurance program developed by UNITE HERE HEALTH to help eligible members and dependents who lost benefits due to no work, layoff, or reduced hours. The goal was to provide much-needed health benefits to participants during a widespread health crisis.

The Super Saver program was suspended for the months of April through September 2021 since free COBRA was available to keep your coverage. Although Super Saver was originally scheduled to end on October 31, 2021, the Trustees have determined that the program will not be available for the month of October 2021 and has permanently ended.
